

STANDARD VARIATIONS APPLICABLE TO COMMERCIAL AND COMMUNITY USERS

The following standard variations are available to commercial and community service users in the categories listed below without specific application to Shoalhaven Water.

Users that fall outside these categories will be considered on a case-by-case basis following application to Shoalhaven Water. These Standard Variations are in addition to the water use allowed by the conditions of the applicable Water Restrictions Levels.

Automatic watering systems and hand held hoses may be used between the hours of 6am – 8am and 6pm – 8pm only. Golf Clubs limited to tees and greens only.
